**Celebrate Wichita's Heritage** – Come discover the early days of Wichita and complete steps to earn your *Heritages* belt loop/pin. Tour the original City Hall building and learn about what makes Wichita special. (60 minutes) \*While you're here, make plans to visit the Central Library, conveniently located just across the street. Discover the genealogy section to learn how to trace family records. **Fun and Games of the Victorian Period** – Travel back in time and learn what your life would be like as a child in early Wichita. Learn to play marbles, complete steps to earn your *Marbles* belt loop/pin, and have some old-fashioned fun! (60 minutes)
