Guided Tours / Programs on Demand:

Celebrating Wichita! – Come discover the early days of Wichita and complete steps to your *Celebrating Community* badge. Tour the original City Hall building and learn about what makes Wichita special. (Suggested for Brownies, 60 minutes)

Playing in the Victorian period – Tour the rooms of a recreated Victorian house and experience daily life in the 1890's. Complete steps to your *Playing the Past* badge and have some old-fashioned fun! (Suggested for Juniors, 60 minutes)

Behind-the-Scenes Tour - Travel back in time and discover the treasures of our city's past. Take a behind-the-scenes look at the building, along with the artifacts and exhibits it holds, and even tour the historic clock tower. (Grades 6-12, 60 minutes)
